Background

Working under the direct supervision of the Health facility Medical Officer and overall guidance of the Senior Medical Officer, the Pharmacy technician is responsible of the running of the health facility Medical Stores and health facility Pharmacy.

1. Diploma in Pharmaceutical Technology, preferably with Technical knowledge in drug supply chain management systems and quality assurance
2. Registered by the relevant and credible body and in possession of current practicing license in Somalia
3. Minimum three (3) years working experience in a Hospital/health facility set-up.

1. Good pharmaceutical knowledge and skills
2. Ability to write clear, concise reports and well developed communication skills
3. Excellent organizational, communication, inter-personal, writing, and communication skills required
4. Good computer skills (Complete MS Office package and any database management and analysis)
5. Must be a team player, flexible and culturally sensitive
6. Ready to work in difficult environmental conditions with displaced communities
7. Ability to accept the possibility of insecurity in the project areas and obey security rules and standard operating procedures
